Case Study

Solution

Eurocoms was tasked with providing an innovative approach to surveillance and access control that could provide real-time intelligence and analysis to our client both onsite and remotely. Eurocoms design team proposed an IP-based surveillance system consisting of 109 vari-focal IP network cameras with built in passive infra-red sensors linked to a Hikvision network video recorder. In addition, Eurocoms proposed the Paxton NET2 system for the access control and door alert recording.

In order to integrate the systems, Eurocoms proposed an IP intruder alarm controller by Texecom which offered all the requirements of the client.

A challenging environment

The client presented an interesting challenge to Eurocoms. Firstly other suppliers had failed to present a workable solution that covered all the requirements set-out by the client and OFSTED. In addition, all the sites were of a different build-type so the cabling installation alone offered a number of challenges. In addition the real-time visual intelligence and post analysis had to be backed up for a minimum 12 months and the door alert event recording to be recorded for 3 years. Dan Ford, Managing Director of Eurocoms said: "The safeguarding of students and staff on these sites is imperative. When specifying the surveillance and door alert systems, the ability to share and access the information is essential in those situations where immediate and urgent action is required."

Eurocoms offered an IP-based system to be deployed and demonstrated how the system would provide all the information and safety required.
